Players for all teams will be expected to abide by a standard set of rules and conduct as set forth in this document.

Players Will ...

1. Display good sportsmanship and team play at all times. Win together, lose together!
2. Display a positive mental attitude.
3. Follow the direction of the Coaching Staff.
4. Make every attempt to be on time and ready to play for all games and practices.
5. Show respect for all opponents, Coaches, players, umpires, league officials and spectators.
6. Inform Coaching staff in a timely manner when unable to attend practice or games. This includes marking your availability on GroupMe.
7. **NOT** use abusive or profane language.
8. **NOT** taunt or humiliate any other player
9. **NOT** abuse, mistreat, or mishandle any baseball equipment or property (eg. throwing batting helmets)
10. **NOT** threaten or fight any person while at any Southeast Angels Baseball game or practice
11. **NOT use any tobacco products or e-cigarettes in the dugout, playing field or park.**
12. **NOT** question an umpire's call.

SE Angels Baseball Parents & Spectators Code of Conduct

Parents & Spectators Will...

1. Be positive role models for the players.
2. Display and instill in all players, the principals of good sportsmanship and team play.
3. Conduct themselves in a manner that best serves the interests of the players.
4. **Show respect for all opponents, coaches, players, umpires, league officials and spectators.**
5. Inform the Coach of any disability or ailment that may affect the safety of their child.
6. Comply with the decisions of Coaches.
7. Remain out of the dugout during games. Discussions with Coaches can be held 24 hours after game end.
8. Be drug and alcohol free while at any SE Angels' event.
9. **NOT** use abusive or profane language.
10. **NOT** ridicule or demean players, Coaches, umpires, or league officials in any public forum.
11. **NOT** use any tobacco products or e-cigarettes in the stands, playing field or park (except in designated areas).
12. **NOT** question an umpire's call.

Violation of any of these rules by either the player or parent can result in diminished player removal from both teams.
